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Preface

The Sovereignty of the universe belongs to Allah Subhanahu wa Ta'āla. He created the universe for humankind, and the humankind is created to worship only Him. Worship of Allah means total submission to His will by doing everything as He has ordained.

A Muslim, by definition, is an obedient servant of Allah. His/ her way of feeling, thinking, and doing should manifest into his/her worshipful attitude to Allah's Sovereignty. The worshipful attitude encompasses two aspects: remembrance (*Zikr*) of Allah, and understanding (*Fikr*) of Allah's Will. The present work has been undertaken to develop this worshipful attitude.

In this book the Qur'ānic supplications (*Ad'iyah*) are collected in sequential order. A simple English translation is rendered in order to make the meaning understood, which can and should lead to a change in behavior of the reader.

The Qur'ānic supplications (*Ad'iyah*), when recited and understood, develop the worshipful attitude in the reader bringing him/her closer to Allah Subhanahu wa Ta'āla. Readers are encouraged to memorize and understand these supplication (*Ad'iyah*). They are further advised to say these *Ad'iyah* regularly in order to inculcate the habit of communicating with, relying upon, and remembering Allah. The purpose is to develop stronger faith (*Imān*) in Allah, in His last Messenger (S), and in the Hereafter (*Ākhirah*), to lay a foundation for a better character, and become a true servant of Allah.
